Website is the go-to resource for those affected by the wildfires.

(Sevierville, TN) March 31, 2017 – Wildfire survivors can find information about employment, housing, counseling, food, supplies, cleanup, rebuilding and more at www.mountaintough.org.

Mountaintough.org website was created to be the official source for those affected by the November 2016 wildfires in Sevier County, Tennessee. The Mountain Tough Recovery Team, chaired by Ellen Wilhoit, oversees mountaintough.org. “This website was created to be one place those who need and want help can go,” said Wilhoit. “We are updating the information as soon it becomes available.”

Survivors wanting counseling can select from a number of providers. By using the “I Need Help” menu, then “Counseling”, they can contact the agency that suits their needs.

People whose homes were not insured or underinsured can receive assistance with clean-up and debris removal. There are (2) two forms under the “I Need Help” menu, click “Clean Up Assistance”. These forms should be completed and sent to the address listed.
